To be able to reduce the chance of accident, prospective operators should go through forklift training by a certified instructor before utilizing a forklift. All aspects of lift truck handling are included in training programs. The abilities and limits of the machine are taught, along with necessary operating procedures, pre-operation inspections and methods of warning other employees that a forklift is in the work site.

Lessons comprise the placement of the chock blocks and trailer tires, the arrangement of pallets in order to distribute the load properly, and checks needed before driving into a trailer at a dock location. Courses also include Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) training. Although not directly related to the operation of a forklift, MSDS training is essential if an operator notices a leaking container or damages a container containing toxic materials. MSDS sheets list the proper ways of dealing with spills, the products and their effects on individuals.
